ADMISSION PROCESS:

1. Eligibility Criteria:

- Undergraduate Courses (B.Tech/B.E.):
 - Completion of higher secondary education (12th grade) with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) as core subjects.
 - o A minimum of 50% marks (45% for reserved categories) in aggregate.

Postgraduate Courses:

- A relevant undergraduate degree from an AICTE-approved institution.
- Minimum marks (typically 50% or more) in the qualifying degree.

2. Admission through Entrance Exams:

• For undergraduate courses, entrance exams like JEE Main, JEE Advanced, and state-level exams are commonly used for admission to engineering institutes..

3. Counseling Process:

- After the results of the entrance exams are declared, centralized counseling sessions are held by various organizations (like JoSAA, CSAB for JEE Main/Advanced). These sessions allow candidates to select and lock their preferences for institutes and courses.
- For state-level exams, respective state counseling bodies handle the allocation of seats.

4. Application Procedure:

- Candidates need to fill out application forms for the respective exams or the institute itself.
- The application can be done online via the official website of the exam conducting authority or the institute.
- Required documents typically include:
 - Mark sheets (10th, 12th, or Bachelor's degree, as applicable)

- Admit card for entrance exams
- Photo ID proof
- Category certificate (if applicable)
- Passport-size photographs

5. Merit List and Seat Allotment:

- After the exams and counseling, institutes publish merit lists based on candidates' performance in the entrance exam and eligibility criteria.
