## **ADMISSION PROCESS:**

### **1. Eligibility Criteria:**

- **Undergraduate Courses (B.Tech/B.E.):**
  - Completion of higher secondary education (12th grade) with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) as core subjects.
  - A minimum of 50% marks (45% for reserved categories) in aggregate.
- **Postgraduate Courses:**
  - A relevant undergraduate degree from an AICTE-approved institution.
  - Minimum marks (typically 50% or more) in the qualifying degree.

### **2. Admission through Entrance Exams:**

- For undergraduate courses, entrance exams like JEE Main, JEE Advanced, and state-level exams are commonly used for admission to engineering institutes..

### **3. Counseling Process:**

- After the results of the entrance exams are declared, centralized counseling sessions are held by various organizations (like JoSAA, CSAB for JEE Main/Advanced). These sessions allow candidates to select and lock their preferences for institutes and courses.
- For state-level exams, respective state counseling bodies handle the allocation of seats.

### **4. Application Procedure:**

- Candidates need to fill out application forms for the respective exams or the institute itself.
- The application can be done online via the official website of the exam conducting authority or the institute.
- Required documents typically include:
  - Mark sheets (10th, 12th, or Bachelor's degree, as applicable)
  - Admit card for entrance exams
  - Photo ID proof
  - Category certificate (if applicable)
  - Passport-size photographs

### **5. Merit List and Seat Allotment:**

- After the exams and counseling, institutes publish merit lists based on candidates' performance in the entrance exam and eligibility criteria.
- Seat allocation is done based on the merit list, reservation policy, and available seats.

## **6. Document Verification and Admission Confirmation:**

- After allotment, candidates are required to go through document verification at the institute.
- Once the documents are verified, candidates confirm their admission by paying the required fees.

## **7. Fee Payment:**

- The final step involves payment of admission fees, which can vary based on the institute and program.

## **8. Commencement of Classes:**

- After the formalities, classes begin as per the academic schedule of the respective institute.
